He reported that he does not always remember medication in the AM, as he is often in a hurry. We discussed using cues in the environment that will remind him every morning when it's time to take the medication. Mr. Smith said that he could try putting a post-it note on the table where his car keys are. We agreed that Mr. Smith would try this, and I will call back in 1 month to check in.	Debbie Coombs

3/9/03	9:50 AM	Mr. Smith said that he had filled his prescription, but had only taken the medication one out of four days so far. He said that he isn't sure he really needs this medication, as he "feels fine" and exercises regularly. However, he did report that his father had died of a heart attack, at about the age that Mr. Smith is right now. Mr. Smith said that he "doesn't like to think about" being at risk for heart disease. We discussed the experience of ambivalence about starting treatment. I asked Mr. Smith to pay attention to his thoughts and feelings about taking medication, and sent him a record sheet to help in keeping track of how his commitment to treatment goes up and down over time.
